Lorraine Brugh is Associate Professor of Music and Director of Chapel Music at Valparaiso University. She is director of the Kantorei there and teaches organ and church music. She has been involved in work on incorporating hymnal materials into worship services, the development of Lutheran music and worship practices (for many years), and is currently President of the Association of Lutheran Church Musicians. Judy Congdon is Professor of Organ and College Organist at Houghton College. Her current and former organ students include winners of organ playing competitions at local, regional, and national levels. In addition to organ she also teaches Organ Literature, Organ Pedagogy, Church Music Administration, Music and Worship, Service Playing (Organ), Counterpoint, and Harpsichord. She was a student of David Craighead at Eastman. Dr, Congdon's workshop will be *Organ Literature for Sunday Services*, *Weddings, and Funerals*. Rick Erickson is Cantor at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in New York City. In that role he directs the Bach Vespers series and oversees the musical life of the parish. He is also Music Director of the Boulder Bach Festival in Colorado. As recitalist Rick has performed in the United States, Germany and Sweden. He has performed for conventions of the AGO, Association of Lutheran Church Musicians and the Pastoral Musicians Association. He is a noted hymn improviser. His teachers included Russell Saunders, David Craighead, and Gerre Hancock. Rick's workshop will be *Improvisation Skills and Hymn Application*.
